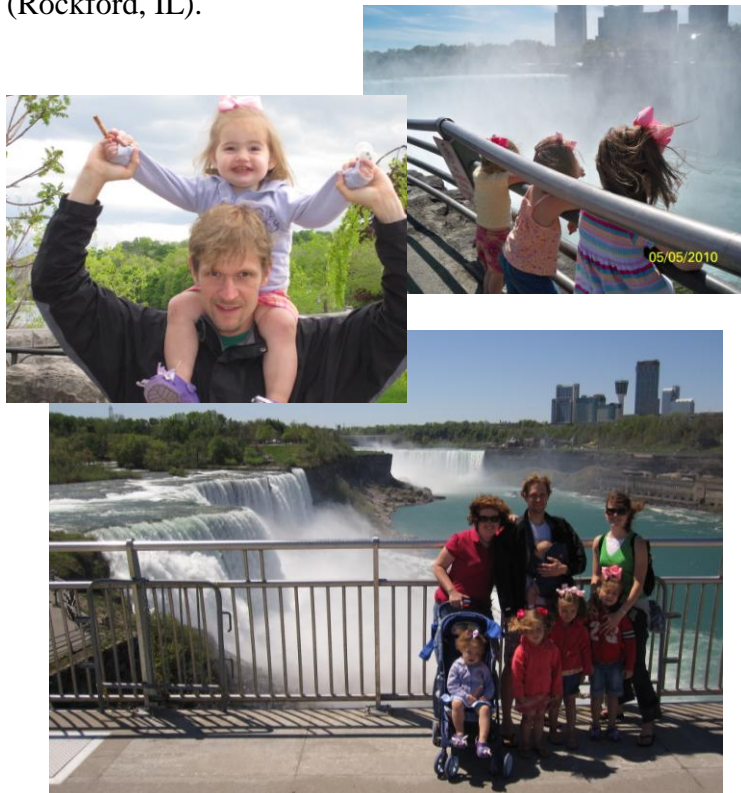

## A prayer request for June-July

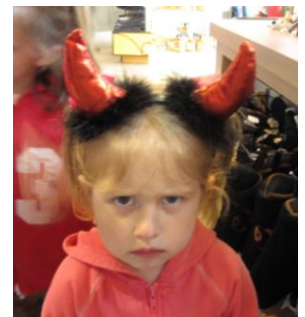
